The recommended length for articles is 1200-1600 words, although shorter articles regarding events and activities are welcome. We generally edit only for mechanics and style, but reserve the right to edit for space and other considerations without prior notification to the author.

We do not accept footnotes, endnotes or bibliographies within an article unless they have received prior approval of the Journal staff.
